5 Core Rules

- 1. Use only when justified by evidence
- 2. Label & date every trap
- 3. Inspect frequently
- 4. Protect non-target species
- 5. Dispose humanely & legally

Placement Guidelines

- Along walls and travel routes
- Behind fixed equipment
- Indoors only
- Out of public view
- Never in open-access areas

Inspection Standards

- Daily in sensitive environments
- Every 48 hours minimum elsewhere
- · All findings documented

→ When Glue Traps Are Justified

- After sanitation and exclusion efforts
- When monitoring confirms activity
- In zero-tolerance environments

5-Step Ethical Decision Framework

- 1. Risk Assessment
- 2. Alternatives Evaluation
- 3. Necessity Determination
- 4. Responsible Implementation
- 5. Review & Prevention
